# **Our Rooms at Kea Preschool**

### **Robins Room (ages 2-3 years)**

Our Robins room is a room for our littlest children aged 2 to 3 years. Our priority is to provide a calm, caring and nurturing environment for your toddler, where they can develop positive attachments and form their first relationships with peers and adults. Children stay in the Robins Room from 9am to 12.00pm and enjoy many activities and have access to the outdoor classroom and outdoor area. At lunchtime, the children join our preschool children and enjoy a socialised lunch altogether. The afternoons are all spent together in our Squirrels room, free flowing inside and outside making memories that will last a lifetime.

## Squirrels Room (ages 3-4 years)

Children thrive in a learning environment which is stimulating. We follow In the Moment Planning, which allows the children to initiate their own learning through their own individual interests. Adults introduce new topics and celebrations through our theme area. We have many areas in our preschool room allowing children to become engrossed in activities. A messy area where children can be artists, a mark making area to make marks and a number area to explore shapes and numbers and much more! A home corner that can be transformed into anything for any adventure and a cosy book corner for times children need to be calm and enjoy some quiet time.


At Kea Preschool we recognise that each child is unique!

Outdoor activities contribute to children's health, their physical development and their knowledge of the world around them. We have beautiful surroundings and regularly go on adventures around our environment. Throughout our sessions, children can free flow between the indoor and outdoor areas, allowing the children to choose where they would like to be.

Wellies are a must!















We have an outstanding outdoor area which is full of learning opportunities. Children can develop many skills from climbing and balancing on the stepping stones, digging for treasure in our large sandpit, being creative in our wooden shelter to filling and pouring at the water tray.

We love children to be outside as much as possible. Our outdoor allows children to cook up a storm in the mud kitchen, develop their gross motor skills as they move tyres, build with logs and much more!

# Throughout the week we offer....

Bikes
Each week the preschool children have the opportunity to put on helmets and use the bikes and trikes in our outdoor area. They learn the skills to help them balance and then we can introduce pedal bikes. We have balance bikes and scooters at Kea Preschool but parents are welcome to bring in their child's bike from home.



There are days where children and staff roll up their sleeves and wash their hands to bake.

Every week is something new and the children learn lots of new skills; rolling pastry, mixing mixtures, kneading dough and of course decorating with sprinkles onto biscuits. The children love choosing what to bake the following week.



We are very fortunate to have such a wonderful outdoor space and we even go further afield to the orchard at Kea School. Our Outdoor learning sessions allow our 3 and 4 year olds to take manageable risks in a safe, risk assessed environment.

We hold our outdoor learning sessions on a Monday and a Friday morning for the children who attend the Squirrels Room. Please ensure that children have waterproofs and wellies at preschool.



We want you and your child to feel happy and safe with us. To make sure that this is the case, the staff will work with you to decide on how to help your child to settle in. We are very flexible with settling in procedures. We recommend booking at least tthree settling in sessions before your child starts their normal booked in sessions, but we understand that some children may require more settling sessions and will work to gradually building this up.

For the first couple of session we ask that a parent or carer stays with your child.


